Tablet and Cell Phone Policies

Tablets

Students may bring tablets to school for use as an educational tool. Students must follow the rules set forth by each classroom teacher in terms of tablet use and storage. ACS practices a zero tolerance policy if a student is found to be using the tablet in a way not deemed appropriate by the school. If a student is found to be using the tablet inappropriately, for the remainder of the year the student will no longer be able to bring the tablet to school.

Cell Phones

Cell phones must be turned in to the homeroom teacher during morning procedures. The students must initial a log each day the cell phone is brought to school, which shows that it was turned in to the teacher. The first time a cell phone is found with a student it will be brought to the principal's office and the parent will have to pick up the cell phone after school. The student will also be required to turn in the cell phone to the principal for the remainder of the year if he/she will be bringing it to school. If a cell phone is found on a student the second time, he/she will no longer be able to bring the cell phone to school.
