Nondiscriminatory Policy

Assumption Catholic School admits students of any race, color, and national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students of the school. The school does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, or athletic and other school-administered programs.

Required Documents

- Verification of active parish affiliation/stewardship
- Health Records
- Immunization Records
- Birth Certificate
- Baptismal Certificate (Catholic applicants only)
- Report Cards
- Standardized Test Results
- Social Security Card (required for all Scholarship and VPK students)
- Record of Psychological Educational Evaluation, 504 Plan, or IEP (if applicable)

All above requirements will be reviewed to determine whether the program at Assumption Catholic School will meet the educational needs of the student. An interview with the student may be part of the admissions process.

Age Requirements and Admission Exam

- Children entering Pre-K3 must be three (3) years of age by September 1st.
- Children entering Pre-K4 must be four (4) years of age by September 1st.
- Children entering Kindergarten must be five (5) years of age by September 1st.
- Children entering 1st grade must be six (6) years of age by September 1st.
- Students will only be fully accepted to Assumption Catholic School based on their performance in our Admissions Exam.

Order of Acceptance Policy

As openings become available, the following priorities will be used to accept students to Assumption Catholic School:

1. Siblings of Current Assumption Students
2. Members of Assumption Catholic Parish
3. Members of other Catholic Parishes
4. Non-Catholic Students

Probationary Period

All new students will be given a trial period of 90 days based on social and academic performance. If during this trial period, concerns arise that are not being met through the partnership of the school and parent(s), a student may be asked to withdraw from Assumption Catholic School.
